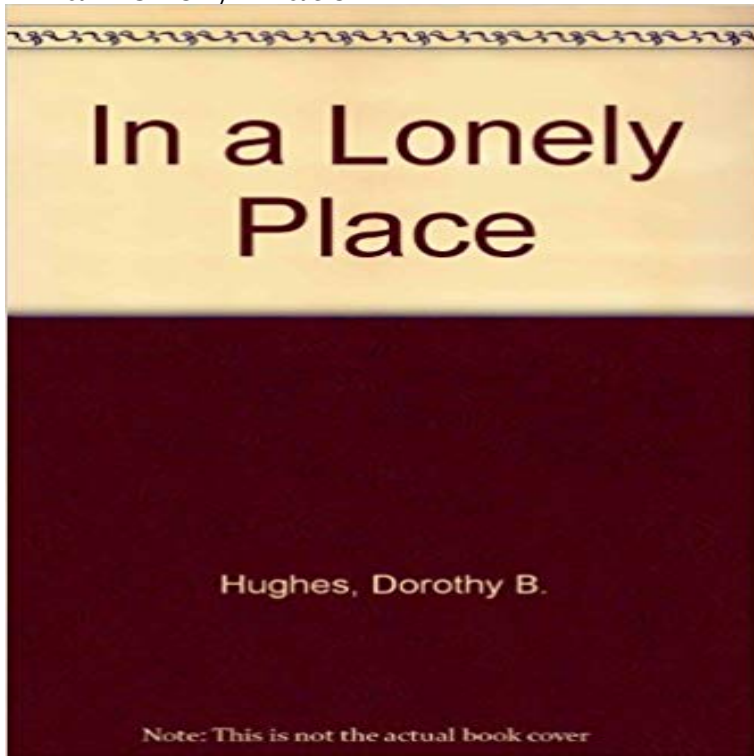


In a Lonely Place
