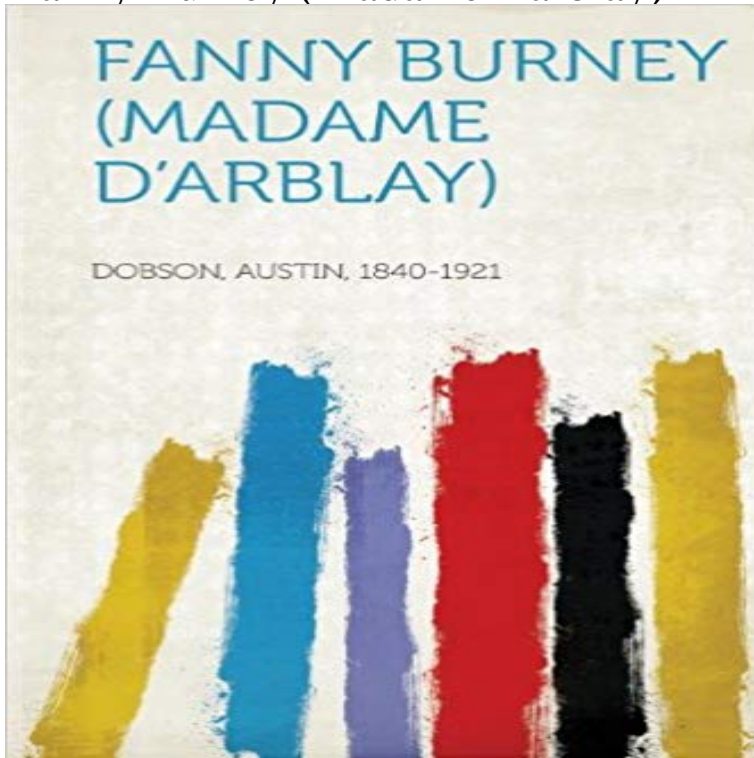


Fanny Burney (Madame Darblay)
