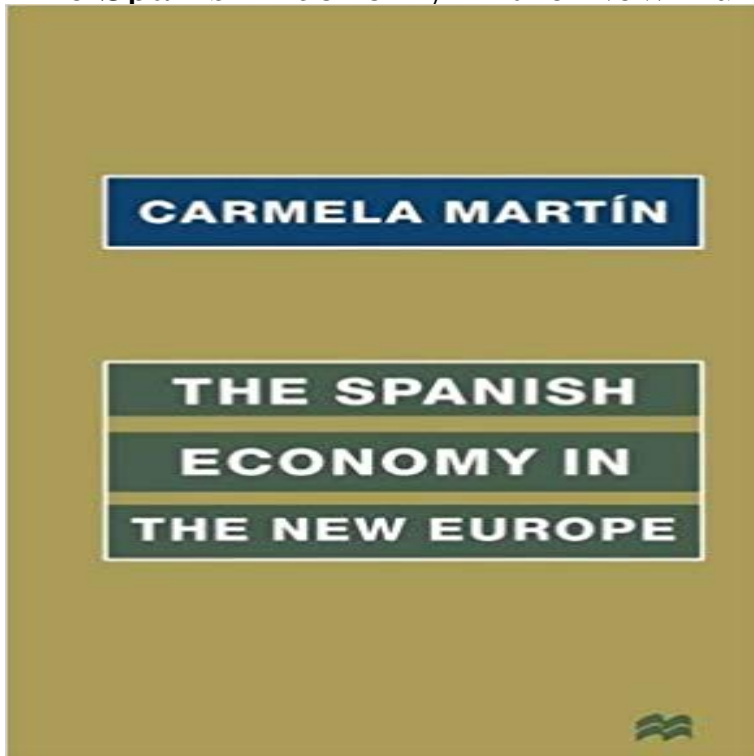


The Spanish Economy in the New Europe
