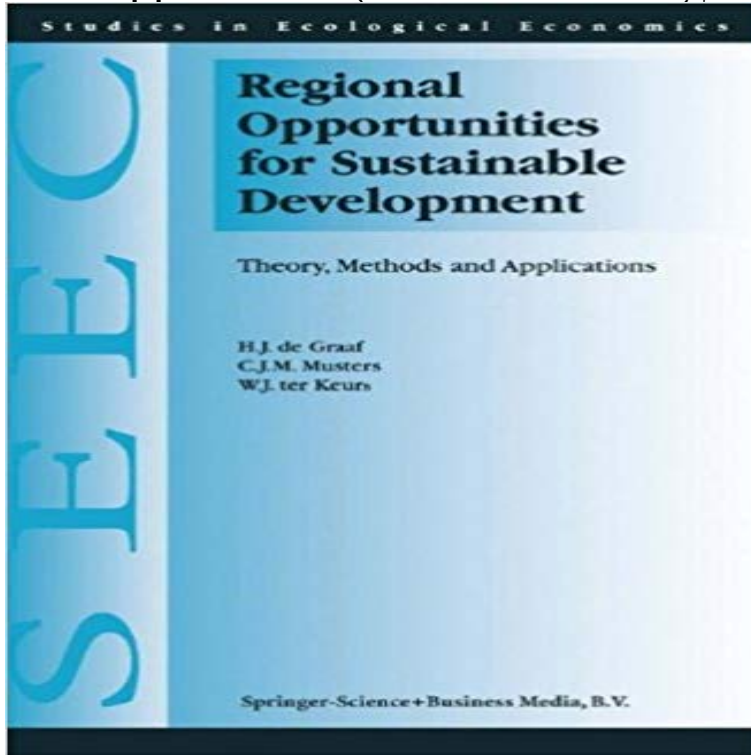


Regional Opportunities for Sustainable Development: Theory, Methods, and Applications (Studies in Ecological Economics)
