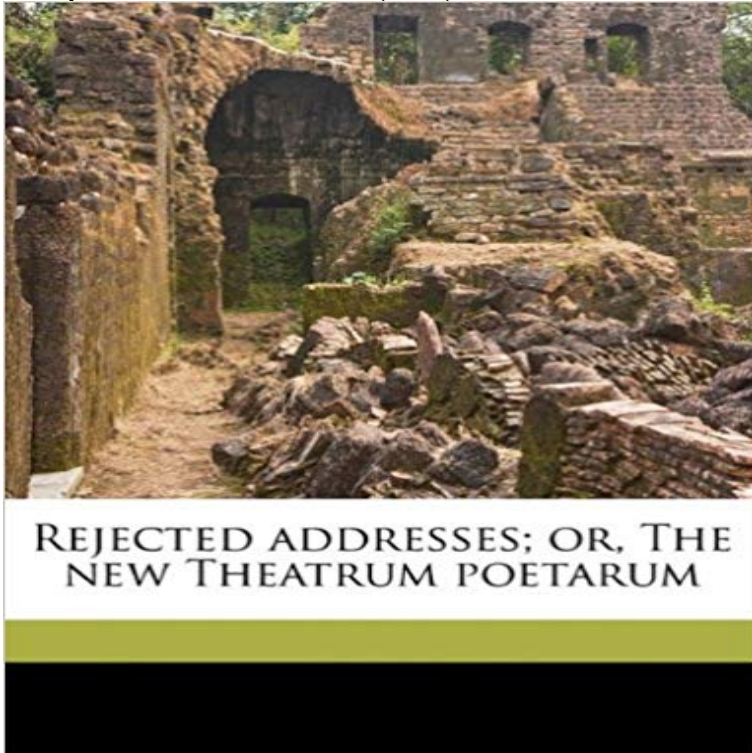


Rejected addresses; or, The new Theatrum poetarum
